

The Rehabilitation Game



GAME DIRECTIONS



- Every player (or team) begins with \$5,000 (four 500s, twenty 100s, fourteen 50s, and twelve 25s). Next, each player (or team) must choose the amount of staff at their facility (the player agrees to pay each staff member \$500 a month at payday); the number of penguins (the player must have a 1:5 staff to penguin ratio) to bring in after the catastrophe; the release site; the monitoring method, and if they want a wildlife veterinarian to come to their facility. They must pay the bank immediately according to their decisions.
- Players decide who goes first based on whose birthday is closest.
- Each player will stop at every penguin and pull from the stack of choice cards. If applicable, the player will choose which option they would like, and then follow the directions on the back of the card. The participant should decide which option would be the best for the lives of the penguins and for the overall budget of their facility. Once the player makes their choice – flip the card over and pay that amount of money to the bank, or receive that money from the bank.
- When the player reaches a payday space, they must follow the directions and pay the bank the appropriate amount. After they have paid the bank, the player may choose to re-evaluate their decisions and correct them if they wish.
- The winner is the player (or team) that has successfully rehabilitated the most penguins and has the most money remaining at the end of the game.
