

TEXAS WATERWAY CLEANUP PROGRAM

Texas Waterway Cleanup Program at the Dallas Aquarium at Fair Park (for ages 10 and up)
The Dallas Zoo has teamed up with Keep Texas Beautiful to offer a special badge program by helping clean the Leonhardt Lagoon at Fair Park. Scouts can participate in just the lagoon cleanup, they can stay for an additional scout badge after the cleanup, or they can make a night of it and join us for an aquarium overnight.

Cleanup Program only: Saturday, April 12, 1:00 p.m. - 3:30 p.m.

Additional scout badge: Saturday, April 12, 1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m.

Aquarium Overnight: Saturday, April 12, 1:00 p.m. - Sunday, April 13, 10:00 a.m.

CHAPERONE REQUIREMENTS:

- ★ Due to space requirements, we strictly adhere to a ratio of 1 adult per 4 children.
- ★ Chaperones must accompany the children throughout their overnight experience and enforce rules regarding Zoo safety and property.
- ★ Girls must be chaperoned by females who are at least 21 years old; boys may have either male or female chaperones who must be at least 21 years old.

★★★ IMPORTANT ★★★

- ★ Minimum group size: 4 children, 1 adult;
- ★ Maximum group size: 75 children, 25 adults.
- ★ We accept registrations from numerous groups for the same date. We must receive registrations for a combined minimum of 15 participants before we can confirm an overnight date.
- ★ Only members of the scout troop and their chaperones will be admitted. Please, no younger or older children.
